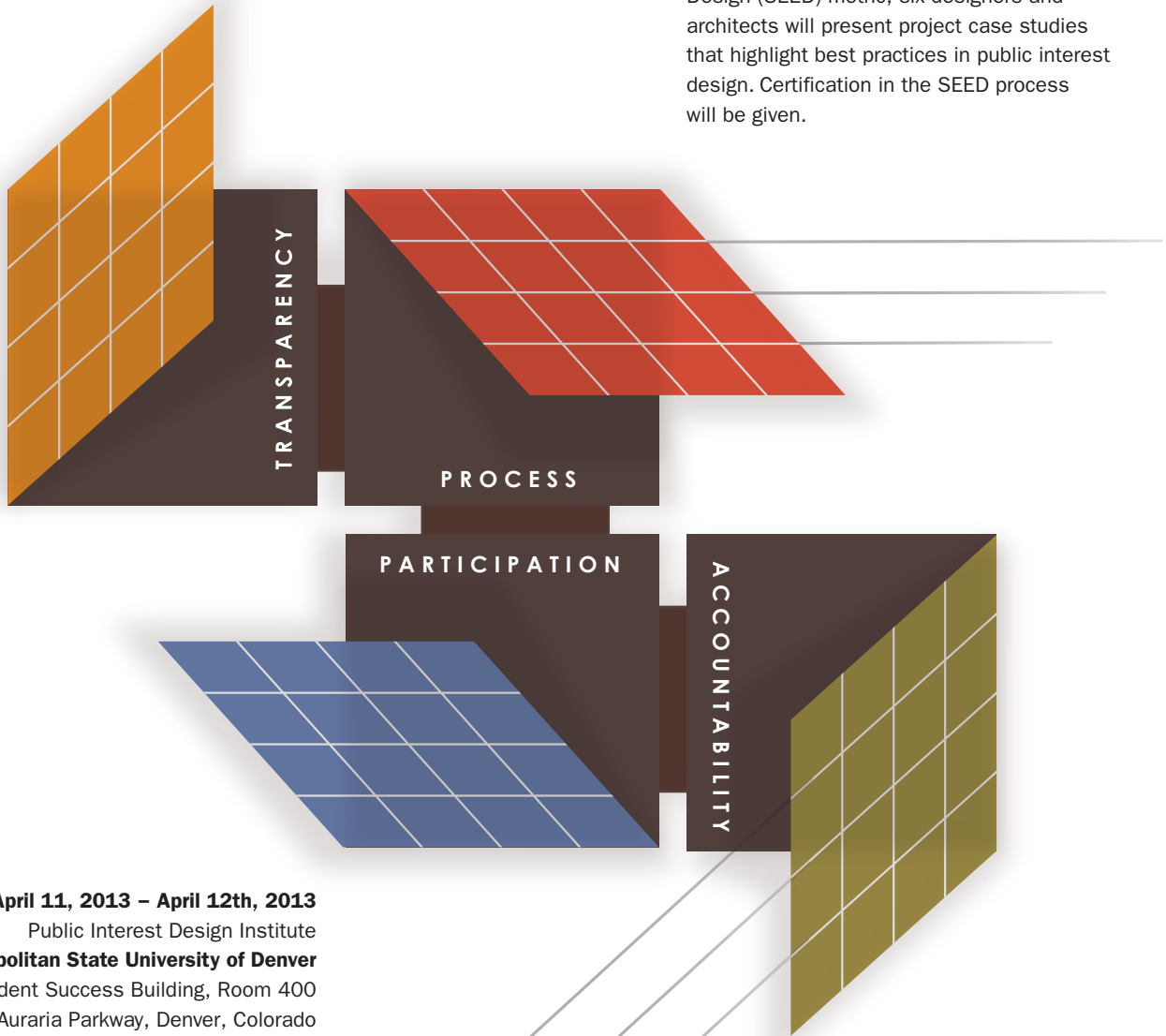


## Empowering Community through Design
